ARGYLL AND BUTE COUNCIL (C32 GLENLONAN ROAD) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

Argyll and Bute Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (as substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991), and having complied with the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Procedure Regulations 1992 and being satisfied that traffic on the length of road as detailed in the Schedule to this Order should be restricted because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near that length of road, hereby make the following Order:

Citation and Commencement

1. Argyll and Bute Council (C32 Glenlonan Road) (Temporary Prohibition Of Traffic) Order 2024 will be in operation daily between 0800 hours from the eighteenth day of January 2024 until 1800 hours on the twelfth day of April 2024, or until the works are complete, whichever is the earliest but will only have effect in relation to part or parts of the length of road when indicated by the appropriate traffic signs.

Interpretation

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Prohibition of traffic

 No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle on the length of road as specified in the Schedule to this order with the exception of vehicles involved in carrying out the works.
